Equine First Aid Kit

- ✓ Names and phone numbers of your veterinarian, farrier, and emergency contacts
- ✓ A thermometer
- ✓ Latex or Nitrile exam gloves
- ✓ Sterile, non-stick gauze pads
- ✓ Vetrap or equivalent
- ✓ Gauze (4x4)
- ✓ Poultice
- ✓ Animalintex or diaper
- ✓ Absorbent cotton roll
- ✓ Eye wash
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Hoof Pick
- ✓ Stable bandages (cottons and overwraps)
- ✓ Chlorhexidine (Hibitane) or Iodine (Povidone or Betadine) soap and/or solution
- ✓ Rubbing alcohol
- ✓ Hibitane, Polysporin, or equivalent antibiotic ointment or cream
- ✓ Insect repellent (Roll-on or SWAT)
- ✓ Duct Tape
- ✓ Extra halter and long rope
- ✓ Twitch
- ✓ Epsom salts
- ✓ Soaking bucket
- ✓ Clean towels
- ✓ Styrofoam pads or boots
- ✓ Ice packs
- ✓ Mineral oil or Vaseline
- ✓ Clean syringes
- ✓ Flashlight with batteries
- ✓ Wire cutters

Heart Rate: 28-40 bpm

Respiratory Rate: 8-16 bpm
